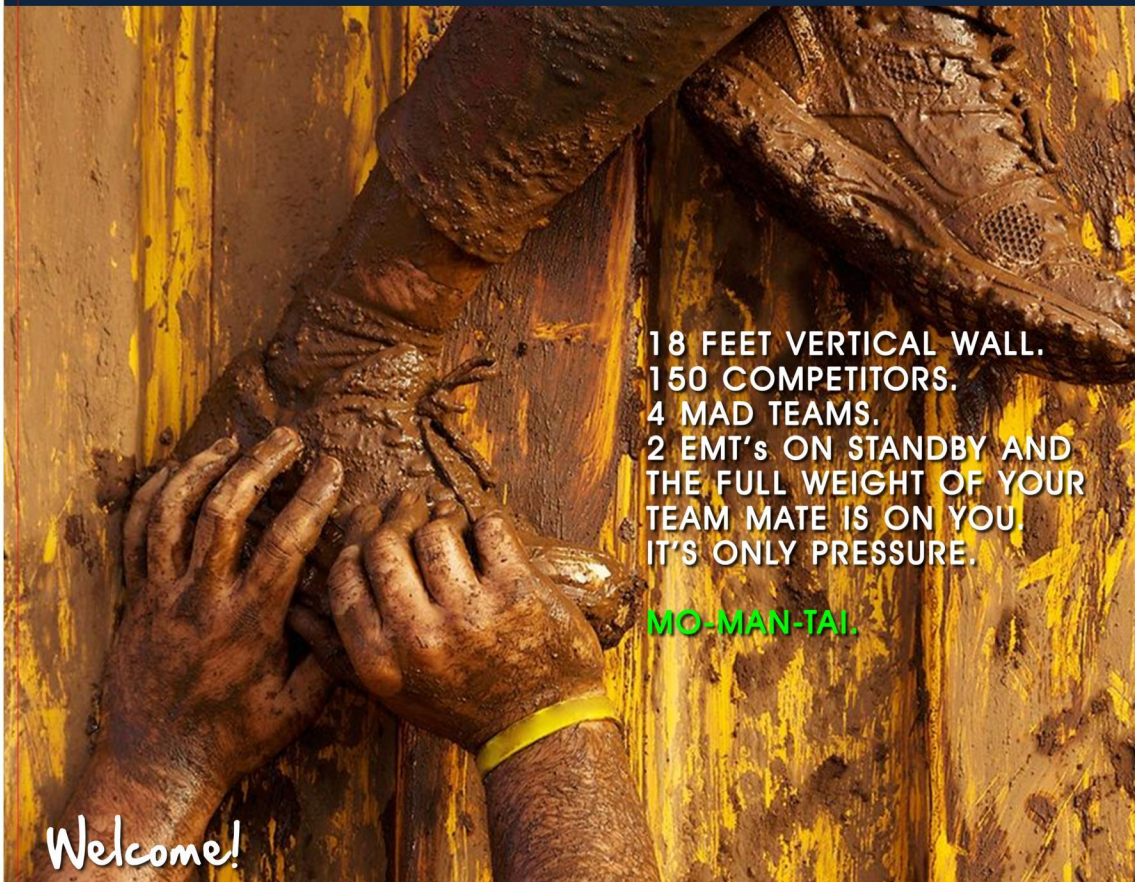

>>> Camper's Checklist...

You need to keep in mind that **M.A.D. 2017 is an outdoor camp**, and not held in a 5-star resort hotel. Instead of a comfy bed, you'll be sleeping in barracks with new-found friends from different states of Malaysia. Most of the comfortable luxuries found in your home won't be available in camp, i.e. hot water, TV, ASTRO, air-conditioning, Wifi, etc... For a **reasonably comfortable stay**, here's a list of things that we'd recommend:

- 1) Clothing T-shirts / shorts / jeans / track bottoms appropriate for meetings, sleeping and games.
We **discourage** new, expensive t-shirts, shorts, skirts, tank-tops or singlets that are either too short, too tight, too transparent, too revealing. *(It's a camp, not modelling school-lah)*
- 2) Footwear 1 pair of used sports shoes (for games and obstacle course) and sandals.
- 3) Toiletries Tooth brush, tooth paste, towel, bathing soap, shampoo etc...(toilet paper is provided).
- 4) **Don't Bring** ● Eating utensils;
● Excessive cash, ATM cards, credit cards, debit cards, etc;
● Jewellery, family heirloom, alcohol, expensive watches, toys, laptops, etc; and
● Swiss Army pocket knives (Anything sharp or resembling a weapon);
- 6) **To Bring** ● Water bottles (water dispensers are available on-site);
● Torch light and mosquito repellent; and
● Swimming trunks, swim-suits, etc. Swimming pool is available. Use of pool is conditional.
- 7) **Your Care** If you bring electronic devices and designer apparels and watches, etc, these items are **under your own personal care**. Electronic devices must be switched off during all meetings. The Campsite owners and Organizing Committee wont be held accountable for loss/damages.
